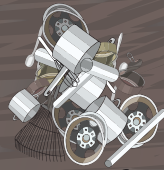

## Local Pharmaceutical Disposal Options

### Fremont Police Department

All controlled and non-controlled substance medications, over the counter and sample medications, vitamins, and inhalers.

### Hy-Vee Pharmacy

All prescription, over the counter, liquid, and pet medications. Must be 4 ounces or less, wrapped in a paper towel, and placed in a leak-proof bag.

### Methodist Fremont Health Pharmacy

All non-controlled substances, over the counter, and liquid medications. Must be 4 ounces or less and in the original bottle.

### Walgreens Pharmacy

All non-controlled substances, over the counter, and liquid medications. Must be 3 ounces or less and in the original bottle.

### Walmart Pharmacy

All controlled and non-controlled substance medications, over the counter and liquid medications. Must be in the original bottle.

### SHARPS

Use a mail-in program or place them in a thick plastic container, tape the lid shut, write "sharps" on the container, and discard in your curbside trash.

# HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION EVENT

**HOUSEHOLDS ONLY - NO Business Hazardous Waste!**

*RESIDENTS OF DODGE COUNTY are welcome to bring their household hazardous waste to this collection site.*

## ✓ Acceptable Waste Materials:

- Oil-Based Paints
- Paint Related Products (stains, varnishes, etc.)
- Poisons
- Fertilizer
- Insecticides & Other Lawn Chemicals
- Herbicides
- Pesticides
- Fluorescent Light Bulbs (standard tubes and CFLs)
- Mercury Containing Items

## ⊗ Unacceptable Waste Materials:

We Will **NOT** Accept The Following:

- **NO** Containers Over 5gal.
- **NO** Latex-Based Paints - May be safely disposed of in your curbside trash once completely dried out or hardened
- **NO** Pharmaceuticals
- **NO** Sharps or Needles
- **NO** PCB's
- **NO** Radioactive Wastes
- **NO** Tires
- **NO** Appliances
- **NO** Household Trash
- **NO** Lead Acid Batteries (May be recycled at most auto stores)
- **NO** Motor Oil
