Local Pharmaceutical Disposal Options

Fremont Police **Department**

All controlled and non-controlled substance medications, over the counter and sample medications, vitamins, and inhalers.

Hy-Vee Pharmacy

All prescription, over the counter, liquid, and pet medications. Must be 4 ounces or less, wrapped in a paper towel, and placed in a leak-proof bag.

Methodist Fremont **Health Pharmacy**

All non-controlled substances, over the counter, and liquid medications. Must be 4 ounces or less and in the original bottle.

Walgreens Pharmacy

All non-controlled substances, over the counter, and liquid medications. Must be 3 ounces or less and in the original bottle.

Walmart Pharmacy

All controlled and noncontrolled substance medications, over the counter and liquid medications. Must be in the original bottle.

SHARPS

Use a mail-in program or place them in a thick plastic container, tape the lid shut, write "sharps" on the container, and discard in your curbside trash.

RESIDENTS OF DODGE COUNTY are welcome to bring their household hazardous waste to this collection site.

▼Acceptable Waste Materials:

- Oil-Based Paints
- Paint Related Products Pesticides (stains, varnishes, etc.)
- Poisons
- Fertilizer
- Insecticides & Other Lawn Chemicals
- Herbicides
- Fluorescent Light Bulbs (standard tubes and CFLs)
- Mercury Containing Items

O Unacceptable Waste Materials:

- We Will **NOT** Accept The Following:
- NO Containers Over 5gal.
- NO Latex-Based Paints May be safely disposed of in your curbside trash once completely dried out or hardened
- NO Pharmaceuticals
- NO Sharps or Needles
- NO PCB's

- NO Radioactive Wastes
- NO Tires
- NO Appliances
- NO Household Trash
- NO Lead Acid Batteries (May be recycled at most auto stores)
- NO Motor Oil
