PHARMACEUTICALS & SHARPS DISPOSAL

Fremont Police Department

Controlled & non-controlled substance prescriptions, over the counter medicines, medication samples, vitamins, & inhalers. NO SHARPS.

Hy-Vee Pharmacy

Controlled & non-controlled substance prescriptions, over the counter medicines, pet medicines, & liquid medicine - 4 ounces or less wrapped in paper towel & placed in leak proof bag. NO SHARPS.

Methodist Fremont Health Pharmacy

Non-controlled substance prescriptions, over the counter medicines, & liquid medicine - 4 ounces or less - in original bottle. NO SHARPS.

Walgreens Pharmacy

Non-controlled substance prescriptions, over the counter medicines, & liquid medicine - 3 ounces or less - in original bottle. NO SHARPS.

Walmart Pharmacy

Controlled & non-controlled substance prescriptions, over the counter medicines, & liquid medicine in original bottle with lid. NO SHARPS.

SHARPS

Use a mail-in program or place them in a thick plastic container, tape the lid shut, write "sharps" on the outside, & discard in your curbside trash.
