Sidewalk Cigarette Receptacle

Early this year, we received a grant from Keep America Beautiful that supplied us with 50 sidewalk cigarette receptacles! Our goal is to distribute these receptacles throughout the community in effort to prevent litter at transition points.



Vehicle Cigarette Receptacle

Cigarettes remain the number one most littered item in the world. Unfortunately, it is not uncommon to see motorists nonchalantly toss a cigarette out the window. With a vehicle receptacle, cigarette waste can remain in the vehicle until there is an opportunity to properly dispose of it.



Vehicle Litter Bag

Motors are responsible for more than half of the litter we see along roadways. By keeping a litter bag in your vehicle, you easily contain your unwanted waste and help prevent roadside litter. As an added bonus, our litter bags contain information on how to report motor litter incidents to the Nebraska Litter Hotline.



Pet Waste Bag Dispenser

Pet waste is more than just an eye sore; it is an environmental health hazard. In fact, pet waste is a major source of water pollution. Please do your part as a responsible pet owner and always clean up after your furry friend.

Littering a misdemeanor offense punishable by a fine in any amount not to exceed \$1,000 and/or imprisonment for any length of time not to exceed 3 months.
