HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION EVENT

Saturday, October 14th, 9:00 a.m. - noon @ Christensen Field

Accepted Items: Oil-Based Paints, Paint Related Products (stains, varnishes, etc.), Poisons, Fertilizer, Pesticides, Insecticides & Other Lawn Chemicals, Herbicides, Fluorescent Light Bulbs (standard tubes & CFLs), & Mercury Containing Items

***Latex paint is not accepted at this event.** It is water-based & not considered hazardous waste once it has been solidified. Please mix latex paint with kitty litter, vermiculite, or commercial paint hardener & allow the mixture to dry or harden completely. When the paint is in solid form, keep the lid off & discard in your curbside trash receptacle.

MEDICATION & SHARPS DISPOSAL

Fremont Police Department

All controlled substance medicines, non-controlled substance prescriptions, over the counter medicines, medication samples, vitamins, & inhalers. NO SHARPS.

Hy-Vee Pharmacy

All prescriptions, over the counter, pet medicines, & liquid medicines, 4 ounces or less, wrapped in paper towel & placed in leak proof bag. NO SHARPS.

Walgreens Pharmacy

All non-controlled substance prescriptions, over the counter medicines, & liquid medicine not exceeding 3 ounces in original bottle with lid. NO SHARPS.

Methodist Fremont Health Pharmacy

All non-controlled substance prescription medications, over the counter medicines, & liquid medicine not exceeding 4 ounces in original bottle with lid. NO SHARPS.

Walmart Pharmacy

All prescription medications, controlled & non-controlled, over the counter medications, & liquid medications in original bottle with lid. NO SHARPS.

SHARPS

Please use a mail-in program or place them in a thick plastic container, tape the lid shut, write "sharps" on the container, & discard in your curbside trash receptacle.
